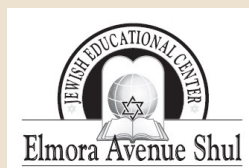

As we will read in the end of the megilla tonight and tomorrow, the Jews in the time of the Purim story focused their energies into re-accepting the Torah. In this light we present these suggestions to enhance your Torah learning. Maybe you only have a few minutes a day to listen or perhaps you're looking for a spiritual boost to your daily car, train or bus commute. Feel free to sample some- or all- of the offerings listed below (these are not presented in any particular order).

The first group below are the shiurim presently offered in our shul this time of year:

Shabbat day Pre-shacharit parsha shiur, Rabbi Herman's gemara shiur and Rabbi Kivelevitz' Dirshu shiur one hour before mincha, Rabbi Herman's mishna yomis shiur ten minutes before mincha and a d'var Torah during se'uda shlishit

Sunday Kollel and EAS chavrusa program in the Reibel Bais Medrash following the 8:30 shacharis

Tuesday Nach shiur by Avie Pinsker (check weekly bulletin for the schedule)

Wednesday Rabbi Herman's Parsha class for ladies followed by the Men's Chaburah (check weekly bulletin for the schedules)

Thursday Rabbi Herman's Gemara class (check weekly bulletin for the schedule)

Sunday-Thursday Rabbi Kivelevitz' Dirshu shiurim (check weekly bulletin for the schedule)
